



How to Do Laundry on Campus

Laundry made simple at Brown

1. Locate the Laundry Room

- Each residence hall has its own laundry room. You can find the specific room number for your building by visiting the Residence Hall Service Rooms page. Follow signage or ask your RA for directions.

2. Get Your Clothes Ready

- Check pockets for any leftover items
- Read care labels on clothing to ensure you are utilizing the appropriate wash cycle
- If you tie dye a shirt on campus, be sure to follow these instructions to not accidentally dye other clothing items

3. Start the Machine

- Select your cycle preference and push to activate washers and dryers.
- If you have any questions, follow the instructions posted in the laundry room.

4. Wash and Dry

- Add laundry detergent to the machine.
- Select a cycle that matches your laundry type.
- After washing, transfer clothes to the dryer and select the appropriate cycle.

5. Be Considerate

- Set a timer to collect your clothes promptly.
- Don't leave clothes in machines unattended for long periods.

6. Laundry Tips

- Bring your own detergent pods or small bottles.
- Use a laundry bag or basket to carry clothes.
- Ask for help if you're unsure—staff and fellow students are happy to assist!
